(Jet Skis, Motorboats, and Other Water Activities)

《 Caution 》

Parking

- Park only in designated areas
- ※ If transporting a jet ski by trailer, use the Haruyama Event Plaza parking area
- Do not set up tents, tables, or other equipment in the parking lot

Beach Use

- Do not claim or occupy large portions of the beach
- Keep the beach clean and take your trash with you

Hours of Use of the Lake

- Use is permitted from 9:00am 5:00pm
- Be considerate of nearby residents and avoid causing disturbances

Designated Areas

- Please refer to the front of the flyer and strictly adhere to the areas for boarding, disembarking and activities.
- When enjoying water activities, be mindful of others on the lake

《 Caution 》

- Please wear a life jacket
- Do not dispose of cigarette ash/butts, oil, or anything else into the lake or on the beach
- Handle fuel with care and pay close attention to safety
- Be considerate of others, both on the water and around you
- Refrain from letting pets swim in the Haruyama swimming area

《 Prohibited Activities 》

- Fire is strictly prohibited within the natural park area
- Barbecues, bonfires, and fireworks, etc. are prohibited
- Do not obstruct the sightseeing boat route *See separate map for route

[For Jet Skis, Etc]

- Do not enter or operate in restricted areas marked with
- Please board and disembark via a licensed operator in the Haruyama area
- The activity zone is generally 200m or more offshore; the area within 100m of the shore is a slow-speed zone
- Do not rev engines unnecessarily
- Boarding and disembarking from the yacht harbor in the Osawa area is prohibited

[For SUPs, Canoes, Etc.]

- If using your own equipment (not through a rental shop or guided tour), please board and disembark from the Haruyama, Katajiri, or Osawa areas
- ※ In the Osawa area, only non-motorized activities are permitted for boarding and disembarking
